Description of the C.V.C.C. Expedition to the Svartisen area of Norway in Summer 1958. The canes occur in a unique band of metamorphosed limestone which falls within the main Caledonian orogenic belt. The band is bounded on either side by mica-schist. The canes zig-zag from side to side along the band, occasionally tunnelling through the schist near the limestone interface. Mr. Smith also gave valuable advice on the organization of foreign expeditions (Ref: CanEx 29; D Jenkins)

In her work on the mode of cave formation & allied studies, Miss Sweeting has travelled abroad on several occasions, most recently for a year's visit to Australia. She describes here, how a large collection of data, obtained from this country and abroad, may shed light on various speleological problems ranging from the rates of solution of active cave systems to the relative abundance of encrustation in caves of hot climatic regions.
