The insurance (and relative documents) had been approved - thanks for Ben and Vicky putting afford in it. I will chase people for their individual forms and sent them to the office before the expedition - this is already mentioned in the previous expedition email by Ben.

- Finances Money is coming in, £1000 in the account, training and some supplies have been paid for but more deposits needed (10 have paid).

- ▲ Thomas will drive the car back
